MEDICAL ACUTE CARE UNIT

Hebrew SeniorLife's Medical Acute Care Unit (MACU) is designed for patients who require extended medical care and rehabilitation due to complex medical conditions or multiple acute and/or chronic illnesses. The Medical Acute Care Unit has received the highest accreditation given by the Commission on the Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF).



Programs Offered

- **Complex Pulmonary Disease and Ventilator Program**, including medical management, 24-hour respiratory therapy, ventilator support and weaning, arterial blood gas analysis, and BIPAP/CPAP devices.
- **Musculoskeletal Rehabilitation Program**, including multidisciplinary medical management and nursing care, prosthetic/orthotic consultation, and physical, occupational and speech/language therapy.
- **Neurological Rehabilitation Program**, including multidisciplinary neurological assessment, IV therapy, spasticity and pain management, and physical, occupational and speech/language therapy.
- **Stroke/Cerebrovascular Rehabilitation Program**, including clinical assessments, bedside endoscopic evaluation, adaptive technology, and physical, occupational and speech/language therapy.
- **Wound Care Management Program**, including multidisciplinary wound assessment, surgical debridement, skin biopsies, compression bandaging, and pain management.
- **Nephrology Program**, including renal consultation, management of complications, and bedside hemodialysis for acute or chronic renal failure.

Commonly Treated Conditions

- **Cardiovascular conditions** – congestive heart failure, coronary artery bypass graft, peripheral vascular disease, and valve replacement.
- **Infectious diseases** – endocarditis, osteomyelitis, pneumonia, urosepsis and others requiring an antibiotics course.
- **Musculoskeletal conditions** – total joint replacement, hip fracture, orthopedic trauma, and complex fractures.
- **Neurological conditions** – stroke, Parkinson's disease, amyotrophic lateral sclerosis, and multiple sclerosis.
- **Respiratory illnesses** – chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, pulmonary hypertension, and complicated pneumonia that requires prolonged antibiotic therapy.
- **Kidney disease** – acute or chronic renal failure, renal osteodystrophy, anemia, hyperparathyroidism, and calcium and phosphate metabolism.

Insurance

The MACU and RSU accept Medicare, Medicaid, Harvard Pilgrim Health Care, Tufts Health Plan, Blue Cross Blue Shield, Commonwealth Care Alliance, and private pay insurance.
