

Brookline Resident Survey Results LeadingAge LTSS Center @UMass Boston

Key questions showing the percentage of respondents who answered "definitely or probably" for each:

"Would you consider moving to a senior living community in Coolidge Corner for yourself?" Total = 80% (n=1001)

"Would you consider having a loved one move to a senior living community in Coolidge Corner?" Total = 82% (n=640)


"Whether or not you choose to live in the senior living community, would you use the community spaces and amenities in the building when completed?" Total = 91% (n=1009)


CONCEPT FOR DEVELOPMENT OF THE CENTRE STREET CAMPUS


- Redevelopment of the 108 Centre Street site into 45 senior all-affordable independent living apartments and common areas with the possible expansion of the Brookline Senior Center in cooperation with the Town of Brookline
- Redevelopment of the 120 Centre Street site into 80-100 market rate assisted living and independent living apartments & common areas
- Enhancements to the overall campus, including landscaping, lighting, and green space




















CONCEPTUAL NEW MASSING










View from East

- Pursue rezoning at Town Meeting to allow the proposed development
