

Code of Respect Community Guidelines

Hebrew Rehabilitation Center is committed to providing an environment for person-centered care where all community members are treated with respect, compassion, and dignity in a safe environment.

- Community members are expected to speak and behave in a respectful manner to all other members of the Hebrew Rehabilitation Center community.
- Please bring patience, kindness, and consideration to your interactions with others.
- We appreciate your collaboration to create a safe, inclusive, and healing environment.

We Do Not Allow:

- Violence or threatening behavior including physical assault, spitting, throwing objects, or destruction of property
- Verbal abuse including yelling, shouting, foul language, intimidation, or angry outbursts toward staff or community members.
- Offensive remarks based on a community member's age, race, ethnicity, religion, culture, ability, language, sexual orientation, gender identity, socioeconomic status, marital status, or other personal traits.
- Sexual remarks, gestures, or physical contact
- Disruption of another patient's care or experience

Response to violations of the above may include:

- Involvement from our security team
- Review of the incident by our senior staff and administration
- Visitors who are not able to comply with this code of respect may be asked to leave the campus
- Visitors with repeated violations may be restricted from visitation in the future
