Rabbi Beth Naditch (she/her) is a board certified chaplain and an ACPE Certified Educator (CPE Supervisor). She has been affiliated with HSL in a variety of chaplaincy and education roles since 2008, and became the Director of CPE in October 2024. Beth received her B.A. from Brandeis University, and was ordained by the Jewish Theological Seminary in 1999. She is an active member of the Rabbinical Assembly of the Masorti Movement. Her areas of teaching expertise include spiritual care through the lens of resilience and trauma, geriatric spiritual care, and using Jewish texts and text study to inform spiritual care. Beth teaches widely in the Boston Jewish community and beyond, including leadership of a long-running women's Torah study class at Mayyim Hayyim. Beth is the co-editor of *Halleli Nafshi*, a siddur for children and youth, and has been the High Holiday spiritual leader of the Havurah of the Capital District, in Albany, NY, for over twenty years.
